Attributes:	<p><b>Audio Visual Capabilities – Video Conferencing System (VCS)</b> – The VCS technology at Half Moon is the most advanced system within a resort in Jamaica. The innovative system is remotely controlled and includes a camera that can pan, tilt, zoom and be pre-set to over 100 different positions. Displayed on a 50" high- definition plasma monitor, the VCS can show video clips, audio clips and data image with a high-powered audio system. A tabletop conference phone allows video calls to be dialed directly. The conference phone has a built-in microphone that lets users speak naturally up to 20 feet away and still be heard clearly.</p> <p><b>Wi-Fi</b> – All of Half Moon's 51 swimming pools offer Wi-Fi Internet access</p>

**Fern Tree Spa-** A world-class 68,000 sq. ft. indoor/outdoor sanctuary for the mind and body featuring a relaxation lounge, yoga pavilion, hydrotherapy swimming pool, sculpture garden and several water features. Drawing from the local lush landscape and centuries-old healing traditions as inspiration, the spa melds modern-day techniques with Jamaica's ancient healing remedies of native herbs, fruits and botanicals.

**Equestrian Center-** Half Moon is the only resort with an on-site equestrian center in Jamaica offering lessons, beach rides and swimming with horses. Budding equestrians can take advantage of Half Moon's signature Beach Ride, which provides riders with an exhilarating swim on horseback into the sea as well as the Jungle Jaunt for riders looking to refresh their skills. Private lessons for every level of rider are also available at the Equestrian Center.

**Golf-** Half Moon has a championship 18-hole golf course. Recently renovated by Roger Rulewich, the course features reshaped fairways, multiple elevation changes and dramatic bunkering that will challenge all levels of golfers. Enhancing the resort's appeal, the Half Moon Golf Academy, allows planners to create custom golf clinics for both groups and private lessons. For a mix of meetings and golf, Half Moon offers a "Meetings on the Green" package. A spacious light-filled meeting room atop the clubhouse has space for up to 30 people and provides easy access to golf lessons that are also included in the package.

**Tennis-** Thirteen lit tennis courts and pros for all levels create a tennis experience that may have some forgetting the beach and hitting the courts. With US Tennis Association-certified pros, Half Moon has gained an enviable reputation for its tennis program that has many visitors coming expressly to play. Guests can test their skills against a lineup of attentive, qualified staff including world-ranked junior pros hand-picked by the tennis and fitness director.

**Water Sports-** Those who prefer water sports can take to the sea and experience SCUBA diving, sailing, and the one-of-a-kind Dolphin Lagoon which offers a variety of dolphin encounters as well as a Trainer for the Day program. Featuring two bottle nose dolphins, the ocean lagoon allows guests to come face-to-face with these mammals while handlers provide a detailed orientation and education session.

**Restaurants-** A culinary paradise, the resort's six restaurants and eight bars have delectable cuisine and signature cocktails to suit the most discerning palate. Guests may dine at the Sugar Mill restaurant which serves Jamaican and international fare, or savour Il Giardino's authentic Italian dishes. For breakfast, lunch and dinner, the Seagrape Terrace beckons with exotic Jamaican ingredients and for lighter fare, La Baguette and the Royal Stocks

are ideal choices. Lovers of Thai and Indian cuisine are also in for a treat at the Akbar/Thai Gardens restaurant.
